CPR plus AED 6 pm to 9:30 pm BLS-HCP 6 pm to 10:30 pm

CPR plus AED (Automated External Defibrillator) 6 pm until 9:30 pm **\$35**

CPR is the critical survival link that buys time between the first link (call 911) and the third link (use the AED). The earlier you give CPR to a person in cardiac or respiratory arrest, the greater their chance of survival. CPR keeps oxygenated blood flowing to the brain and heart until defibrillation or other advanced care can restore normal heart action. The North Lake Tahoe Fire Protection District wants to promote the most rapid possible defibrillation of victims of cardiac arrest. AED rescuers can provide defibrillation within the first few minutes of out-of-hospital cardiac arrest. This dramatically increases the victim's chances of survival.

FIRST AID with CPR plus AED ... 8 am to 5 pm **\$70**

This 8-hour course provides the student with the basic skills to respond to a sudden injury, cardiac or respiratory emergency. The course meets the OSHA requirement for workplace first aid training.

BLS-Health Care Provider 1 pm to 6pm **\$45**

NEW Certificate or REFRESHER ...

This AHA course is designed to meet the needs of healthcare professionals who respond to cardiac and respiratory emergencies in a wide variety of settings. (Doctors, nurses, paramedics, EMTs, Firefighters, Cops, Medical/Dental Assistants, ski patrollers, etc...) The course satisfies the employment requirement for healthcare providers and the prerequisite course for the AHA ACLS course.
